WELCOME TO JOHNSON HALL MUSEUM, A WEDDING & EVENT SPACE IN WELLS, MAINE.

The museum has an interesting history dating back to the roaring 20's. The main building was Libby's Tea Room (1923-1941) where a lobster dinner was only \$1.50 and where Franklin D. Roosevelt stopped to eat in 1932 while campaigning for president. The Museum still has the guest book with FDR's signature.

Situated conveniently on Route One near the coastal villages of Kennebunk, Kennebunkport, Wells and Ogunquit, Johnson Hall Museum and its newly renovated Tea Room offer a unique, historic location for an elegant wedding or memorable social or corporate event.

The Johnson Hall Museum can host your rehearsal dinner, wedding ceremony, cocktail hour and reception, as well as provide unique and interesting backdrops for your wedding photos. Our 10-acre grounds are historically and architecturally stunning and offer one of a kind photographs to capture the essence of your memorable day.
